

Cell Organelle Menu Project

In this menu-project, you will have a choice as to what you would like to do to get your 100 points for this project grade (remember – this is the same as a test grade). Your goal is to choose as many projects to get to 100%. Remember to do your BEST on each project so that you can get the BEST grade possible. Not all of these have to be done on the computer. Paper and art supplies are provided in class to complete anything you need to on paper.

Try to challenge yourself!

Worth 20 POINTS:

- Create a Venn diagram that compares and contrasts the structure of plant and animal cells. 
- Create a crossword puzzle on Discovery PuzzleMaker with at least 12 vocabulary words about cells
- Create a text conversation (<http://www.ios7text.com/>) between 2 organelles talking about their day at work – be sure to include what each organelle does in the conversation

Worth 30 POINTS

- Create a job advertisement for a ‘Cell Company’ (feel free to come up with a company name) which is looking for an organelle to complete a certain job in their company. Be sure to include a list of ‘Looking for’ abilities and a picture of the organelles that usually complete that job in the company
- Create an obituary for an organelle that has passed away. Feel free to give it a name, what they did during their life (including their job), as well as any friends and relatives that survive them. Be sure to include a picture of the deceased.
- Create a museum exhibit – a detailed creatively artistic drawing with a description of the organelle as the plaque that goes with your art
- Go to <http://www.makebeliefscomix.com/Comix/> and create a short comic strip about an argument between a plant cell and an animal cell about who is better – more complex, smart, etc.
- Use Audacity to create a 30-second commercial about a sale on organelles at the local Cells’R’Us Store. Remember – commercials have to be creative or no one will buy your stuff. Feel free to use sound effects...
- Create a ‘Peek-a-Boo’ Cell Foldable. Ask Mrs. Battistone for instructions.

Worth 50 POINTS

- Create a Prezi (search on Google and create a free account) with at least 8 slides that have at least 2 pictures of each organelle and a description of what that organelle does (*cannot be combined with Flipbook / Animoto activity*)
- Think of a common or popular song (doesn't have to be complicated) and change the lyrics to learn about the organelles of the cells or the differences between plant and animal cells – type us the lyrics and be sure to note what song to use to sing along to
- Complete the Flipbook activity (ask Ms. Battistone for the paper with the instructions) – *cannot be combined with the Prezi or Animoto activity*
- Create an Animoto video with music – use Google Image searches to download different images of the 8 different organelles, write a caption for each picture and create a short 30-sec movie about the different cell organelles (*cannot be combined with the Prezi / Flipbook*)
- Use a different website that you would like to try OR have used before (Piktochart, Blabber, Scratch, or find your own, etc) to create an informative message about cells – be sure to include at least 6 important facts.
- Use EduCanon (think the Cell Theory video) to find a video on YouTube and create an EduCanon video complete with questions! Make sure you have at least 10 questions.
